For what purposes and on what legal basis do we process your data?

1. **For the purpose of organizing and conducting the conference**, including registration of participation and providing organizational support for the event (in particular confirming participation, providing organizational information, contacting you - including by phone - regarding logistical matters and the provision of additional services such as catering), as well as for the purpose of implementing the provisions of the **Conference Regulations** - on the basis of **Article 6(1)(b) GDPR** (necessity for the performance of a contract for participation in the conference).
2. If the Participant takes part in a **competition organized during the conference** and obtains the status of a winner, personal data may also be processed for the purpose of fulfilling our **legal obligations**, in particular regarding **tax settlements, reporting and accounting**, on the basis of **Article 6(1)(c) GDPR**.
3. For the purpose of **establishing, pursuing or defending against claims**, which constitutes the implementation of our legitimate interest, as well as for **archival purposes**, on the basis of **Article 6(1)(f) GDPR**.
4. During the conference, the **image of Participants may be recorded** in the form of photographs or video recordings. The image will be processed **only on the basis of the voluntary consent of the Participant - Article 6(1)(a) GDPR**. Consent may be withdrawn at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before its withdrawal. To withdraw consent, contact us at kontakt@securitymasters.pl.
5. For the purpose of **sending marketing content**, if you have consented to receiving it, on the basis of the Participant's **voluntary consent - Article 6(1)(a) GDPR**.

Providing personal data is **voluntary but necessary** to participate in the **Conference**.

To whom will we disclose your personal data?

These entities may have servers located **outside the European Economic Area (EEA)**. Data transfers take place on the basis of **standard contractual clauses** concluded with the above entities, which are also **participants in the EU-US Data Privacy Framework (DPF)**.

We may also transfer your personal data to other recipients entrusted with processing personal data on our behalf, including entities providing **IT services and accounting services**.

Your personal data may also be made available to **law firms providing legal assistance** to us. Your data will also be disclosed **upon request to authorized public administration authorities**.

How long will we process your personal data?

Your personal data will be stored for **12 months from the date of the event**.

In the case of **competition winners and prize recipients**, documentation confirming compliance with legal obligations will be stored for **5 years from the end of the year in which the benefit was granted**.

Where processing is based on **your consent**, the data will be processed **until the consent is withdrawn or the purpose of processing expires**.

What rights do you have?

By contacting us using the details indicated above, you may exercise the following rights:

1. the **right to withdraw consent** to the processing of your personal data;
2. the **right of access** to your personal data and to obtain a copy of the processed personal data;
3. the **right to rectify inaccurate data**;

4. the **right to request erasure of data (the right to be forgotten)** in the circumstances provided for in **Article 17 GDPR**. In some cases we may refuse to delete the data if their processing is still necessary, e.g. to comply with a legal obligation or to establish, pursue or defend claims;
5. the **right to request restriction of processing** in cases indicated in **Article 18 GDPR**;
6. the **right to object to data processing** in cases indicated in **Article 21 GDPR**;
7. the **right to data portability** of the data you have provided, processed by automated means, where the legal basis for processing is **consent or performance of a contract**.

We also inform you that you have the **right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO)** (<https://uodo.gov.pl/pl/p/dla-obywatela>) if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the **GDPR**.
