



Terms and Conditions of Participation in the Security Masters Conference

§1 General Provisions

- 1. These terms and conditions (hereinafter: "Terms") define the rules for participation in the Security Masters conference organized by SECURITY MASTERS Sp. z o.o., owned by Damian Wróblewski, KRS: 0001084202, REGON: 527558257, NIP: 5273095404 (hereinafter: "Organizer").**
- 2. The conference will take place at the headquarters of Microsoft Poland in Warsaw.**
- 3. The purpose of the conference is to exchange knowledge and experience in the field of cybersecurity, as well as to integrate experts and individuals interested in IT security.**
- 4. Participation in the conference is equivalent to acceptance of these Terms.**

§2 Conditions of Participation

- 1. A conference participant (hereinafter: "Participant") may be a natural person who has completed registration in accordance with the rules specified by the Organizer.**
- 2. Registration for the conference takes place via the official website of the event or by another method indicated by the Organizer.**
- 3. The number of places at the conference is limited. Admission is determined by the order of registrations.**
- 4. Participation in the conference is free of charge.**
- 5. Providing a current email address and phone number by the Participant is a condition for participation in the Conference in order to ensure efficient organization of the event, in particular to confirm participation, provide ongoing organizational information, and enable contact regarding matters related to the course of the Conference.**
- 6. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse registration of a Participant without providing a reason.**

§3 Course of the Conference

- 1. The conference program will be announced on the official website of the event and may be subject to change.**
- 2. The Organizer reserves the right to introduce modifications to the schedule of presentations and the list of speakers.**
- 3. During the conference, additional events may take place, such as competitions, discussion panels, and sponsor presentations.**
- 4. Conference participants are required to comply with the safety rules applicable at the conference venue.**

§4 Rights and Obligations of Participants

- 1. Participants are required to observe the principles of personal conduct and not disrupt the course of the conference.**
- 2. Participants may not record speakers' presentations without the explicit consent of both the speakers and the Organizer.**
- 3. Participants undertake to use conference materials solely for their own personal use, without the right to further distribute them.**
- 4. The Organizer reserves the right to remove from the conference any person who violates the Terms, without the right to a refund of registration fees (if applicable).**
- 5. Participants acknowledge that participation in the Conference involves the possibility of their image being photographed and recorded during the event, as well as its free-of-charge distribution by the Organizer for promotional, documentary, and marketing purposes. - 6. The Organizer exercises due diligence to ensure that photographic and audiovisual materials from the Conference present participants as part of the overall event and do not violate their rights, including the right to image. However, due to the nature of the event and the manner in which it is documented, a participant's image may be recorded incidentally. If a participant raises objections regarding the use of their image, the Organizer will promptly take action to limit further distribution of the material.**

7. If a participant does not consent to the distribution of their image, they should inform the Organizer during the event or at any time after the event.

§5 Personal Data Protection

1. The Organizer is the controller of the Participants' personal data.

3. The Organizer may process the image of Participants recorded during the conference for documentary and promotional purposes in accordance with §4 point 5.

§6 Liability

1. The Organizer is not responsible for items left unattended, lost, or stolen during the conference.
2. The Organizer is not responsible for the content presented by speakers.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the conference or change its format for reasons beyond its control (e.g., force majeure, unforeseen circumstances).

§7 Complaints

1. Any complaints regarding the organization of the conference should be submitted in writing to the Organizer's email address within 7 days after the event ends.
2. The Organizer will review complaints within 14 days from the date of receipt and will inform the Participant of the outcome.

§8 Final Provisions

1. These Terms are available on the conference website and at the event venue.
2. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms for important reasons, provided that such changes do not infringe upon rights already acquired by Participants.
3. In matters not regulated by these Terms, the relevant provisions of Polish law shall apply.
4. Any disputes arising from participation in the conference will be resolved by the competent court according to the seat of the Organizer.
